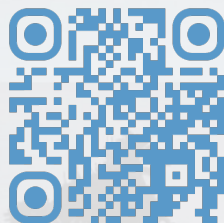

The conference of the Nuclear Society of Slovenia is an international annual meeting of professionals dealing with different aspects of nuclear energy from all around Europe and worldwide. The primary objective of the meeting is to foster international cooperation amongst professionals active in nuclear research and educational institutions, nuclear vendors, utilities and regulatory bodies.

The year 2026 marks the 60th anniversary of the JSI TRIGA Mark II research reactor, highlighting the enduring role of research reactors in advancing nuclear science, technology, and education.

Call for Papers

Authors are invited to submit abstracts before **May 15, 2026**. Abstracts (not exceeding 850 words) should be submitted through **the NENE conference website** (not by e-mail). Please **create an account, login** and **submit** the abstract. Authors may also indicate their preference about the type of presentation and the topic.

The Program Committee will review the abstracts and inform the corresponding authors about the acceptance and the type of presentation before **June 30, 2026**.

Young Authors Award

An award will be presented for the best paper prepared by a first author aged **no more than 32 years**. The number of co-authors is limited to a maximum of two additional authors (advisers).

The Young Authors Award Committee will review the eligible papers and select the winner. Full-length papers competing for the Young Authors Award should be submitted before **August 20, 2026**. **Candidates are kindly requested to indicate their intent to participate in the contest when submitting the abstract.**

Best Poster Award

The best poster will be selected by the Best Poster Award Committee. The posters will be evaluated according to clearness of objectives, results and conclusions, as well as aesthetics and attractiveness.

Papers and Proceedings

Submission of full-length papers (not exceeding 8 pages) is due by **August 31, 2026**. A peer review of full-length papers will be performed before including the papers in the Proceedings.

Proceedings containing peer-reviewed papers presented at the conference will be published after the conference.

Language

The language of the conference is English.

Venue

The conference will take place in **GH Bernardin**, the largest convention hotel in Slovenia. Its wonderful location close to the sea provides inspiring working atmosphere.
